So that students do not fall behind, I will be posting detailed weekly learning packages and assignments on **Google Classroom** along with supplementary videos. Students are asked to attempt to complete assigned work on a weekly basis.

I will be checking into **Google Classroom** throughout school hours to assist with any concerns or questions you may have.

Since my last conversation and last post on **Google Classroom**, the streams of information educators have been receiving have changed.

For various reasons brought forth by the ministry, and board, my plan for using videoconferencing to teach also has had to change. For now, I will hold off on video-conferencing at this stage of your child's online learning and will be posting detailed weekly learning packages and assignments on **Google Classroom** along with supplementary videos instead.

I will be checking into **Google Classroom** throughout school hours to assist students with any concerns or questions they may have.

Given the challenges of remote education, it would be beneficial, if possible, for parents to partner in the facilitation of the education of their child. Students should be logging into **Google Classroom** daily to check messages, receive or work in assignments. As a parent, by checking (answering questions about the assignments, asking questions about content and/or checking completed work) at least every other day will help to ensure your child is meeting assignments and understanding the content. If after parental support, your child is still struggling please have them contact me through **Google Classroom** or e-mail.
